The Christian Neighbors recent quarterly meeting served as a recap for the organization's past year's work and financial standings. Although the number of families Christian Neighbors served rose modestly – 6 percent – the number of visits and assistance needed from these households increased greatly. The graph below represents the areas of greatest need.
