Words of Integration & Guidance

In today's Gospel reading, Jesus says, "It is God's good pleasure to give you the kingdom." What is the kingdom? It's not a physical place, but rather a dimension of consciousness. On a metaphysical level, we might understand the kingdom of God to be, in a sense, the source of the Source. It is the place of absolute Truth, absolute Love, and absolute Power from which everything else expresses. The kingdom of heaven is a dimension of consciousness that represents the next step in our own collective and individual spiritual unfoldment. It is, Jesus assures us, within us—and it is at hand. It exists as our own potential. As we recognize, embrace, and express the Christ Presence of God that is our true identity, our faith, and the choices that emerge from that faith, create a world that more perfectly expresses spiritual Truth. As we stop believing in and choosing from thoughts of fear and negative feelings, we experience the kingdom of heaven in ourselves and share it with others. This possibility is "at hand"—it does not happen after death, and it is not a pre-existing place to which we must find our way. It is the true potential of each of our lives. Jesus achieved a full realization of the kingdom of heaven in his own mortal life—and even the challenges and pain of his final days could not shake him from its state of perfect Oneness and perfect Peace. He calls us to do the same—to express our own Christ energy so that we, too, can experience the kingdom—and by sharing it, make it our full and complete experience here on Earth.

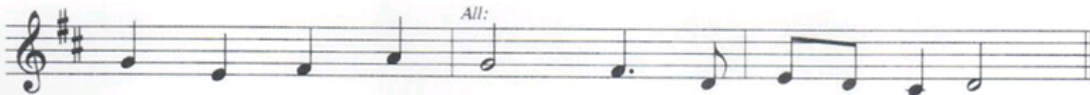
