Season of Lent: This sacred Season of Lent provides an opportunity for us to draw closer to God each day through prayer and contemplation. During the Lenten season, we invite you to take part in our Thursday night meditations in the church from 5 to 6 PM, as well as to pray each day with the UCC's Lenten devotional, available for purchase in our Friendship Hall.

Lenten Book Read: More than 30 people have been participating this month in our Lenten book study of *Rise: An Authentic Lenten Devotional* by John Pavlovitz. We have been meeting every Wednesday from 3 to 4 PM in the Friendship Hall. The conversations have been so rich and meaningful.

An Evening with John Pavlovitz: A sold-out crowd packed Douglas UCC on Saturday, March 11, as we welcomed popular author and activist, John Pavlovitz, back to our church. More than half of the people in attendance were visitors. The event raised \$1,000 for our church.

Maundy Thursday: Our Maundy Thursday supper and service will take place on April 6 at 6 PM. This powerful service commemorates Jesus's last meal with his apostles and his seven last words. We will begin in the Friendship Hall with a simple meal of soup and bread, followed by a time of prayer and reflection in the church. More than 50 people have already signed-up.

Christian Neighbors: Last month, we are collected 121 jars of peanut butter for Christian Neighbors Food Pantry in Douglas. Thank you to everyone for their generous giving.

Easter Lilies: We hope to fill our altar with lily plants for our Easter Sunday service. Congregants can purchase a plant for \$15 in memory of a loved one whose name will be printed in our Easter Sunday program. More than 30 plants have already been sold! Thank you!
