Gun Violence Vigil: Hannah Huggett and our church's Social Justice Team will be facilitating a *Vigil for the Victims of Gun Violence* on Saturday, December 14, at 7 PM in the church. We have held this vigil the past few years to coincide with the national vigil on the anniversary of the Newtown tragedy.
