

## **Christian Neighbors, Inc.**

### **October – December, 2021 Report**

Christian Neighbors continues to thank God for your generosity in sharing this beautiful facility. We are happy to share the following details of our services during the last quarter of 2020.

- 250 Different families were served – a total of 531 visits (compared to 351 for the same time last year).
- These families received food and over 4300 pieces of used clothing, 100 packages of diapers, 80 sets of used linens, 107 sets of towels, and 50 blankets. This too is a significant increase.
- 58 different volunteers worked a total of 1,629 hours! In addition, there were more than 70 different people working the fall projects (Coat distribution, Thanksgiving, and Christmas) for a total of about 530 hours.
- The Thrift Store continues to be a busy place. Clients receive free clothing and linens, towels, blankets, and diapers as needed. We also welcome shoppers who can find many bargains.
- Winter Coats – 71 families received 202 coats. Elementary age children also received snow pants. All received hats and gloves.
- Thanksgiving – 340 families received food baskets. This included 99 from local churches, 119 from Pullman, and 122 CN clients.
- Christmas – 117 families with children shopped for clothing and toys. 336 children received hoodies or sweatsuits and pajamas; plus 775 toys/gifts and about 1000 stocking stuffers. This is an increase of 120 children from last year. 130 families received a food basket.
- The following assistance was provided to client families:
  - Electric - 24 families - \$6,418.00
  - Heat - 16 families - \$7,552.00
  - Rent - 33 families - \$13,505.00
  - Gasoline – 82 families - \$ 7,791.00

The total spent is an overall increase of about 250%.

- The following grants were received from the Delano Foundation for the 2020/2021 fiscal year:

- o \$1,000 for purchase of diapers
- o \$2,000 for purchase of winter coats
- o \$6,000 for utility assistance (heat and electricity)
- o \$1,000 for purchase of gas cards
