Who of us has not grieved often - in many ways for many reasons - through many times in our lives? Often grief gets ignored, stuffed, avoided, because it is painful, and who likes pain? But grief not acknowledged and processed can cause significant injury in our lives.

In this session on grief, we will explore our experiences of grief and how grief can become a source of good. The little classic book by Granger Westberg titled "Good Grief" will be a resource for our consideration. You are invited to read the book, but come to our session whether or not you have read it.
